Increase Student Achievement

By June 2023, all students will make one year's growth in Reading, Math, and Science.

By June 2023, KISD will develop a 3-year literacy plan through the new adoption process of ELA K-8 (phonics, reading, and writing).

By June 2023, KISD will increase the number of National Merit students by identifying cohorts of students through the 9th and 10th-grade PSAT administration.

By June 2023, KISD will increase CCMR (College Career Military Readiness) designations so that students leave Keller ISD ready for college, the workforce, or the military.



Student Community Parent Relationships

By June 2023, the Keller ISD Communications Department will increase public awareness of the positive image of all Keller ISD schools as measured by original video views and percentage of campuses and District functions receiving positive coverage.



Excellence in Processes and Systems

By June 2023, the Special Education department will develop and implement increased monitoring procedures and processes to improve and enhance compliance.

By June 2023, the Keller ISD Special Education Department will improve educational outcomes for students with disabilities through training and support of high quality instructional and inclusion practices.

By June 2023 Technology will develop and implement a replacement cycle plan



Employee Excellence and Organizational Improvement

By June 2023, the KISD Human Resource Department will continue to recruit, train and retain high quality substitutes so that the district will maintain an absence fill rate of 85% or higher throughout the year.
