Parkwood Hill Arrival & Dismissal Guide

The following guidelines have been developed to ensure the safety of all children arriving and departing our campus. Please read below, call our office with any questions, and remember to always drive friendly.

Curbside Information

There are two lanes of traffic for each driveway entrance. In the right-hand lane, your child must exit your vehicle by stepping onto the curb to the right. In the left-hand lane, your child must exit your vehicle by stepping onto the curb to the left. Please seat your child on the side where he/she will exit.

Your child can exit your vehicle anywhere along the entire length of the curbed drop-off zone and walk to a front door. This allows more cars to drop off at once. *Please do not wait to drop off your child at the front door, or at the very front of the line, as this will slow the entire line of traffic.*

Naturally, our driveways have heavier traffic during inclement weather. Please be patient and plan for longer wait times.

Safe Practices

As a parent who cares for the safety of your child and other children, please...

- ...be kind and polite while cooperating with fellow drivers.
- ...obey all posted signs and follow all directions given by teachers, staff, and/or volunteers who are here for the safety of our children.
- ...require your child to use the marked crosswalks, which are the only safe, permissible way to cross the driveway/street.
- ...remain with your vehicle during our arrival/dismissal windows, which are 7:00 8:00 a.m. and 2:30-3:30 p.m. Vehicles cannot be parked & unattended in driveways.
- ...drop-off only at a monitored, driveway curb. Drop-offs are not permitted in parking lots, behind our building, along Parkwood Hill Blvd., or elsewhere.
- ...refrain from cell phone use. The active use of a cell phone is prohibited by law while driving in a school zone.
- ...refrain from the use of tobacco products. Smoking or using tobacco products is prohibited by law while on school grounds.
