

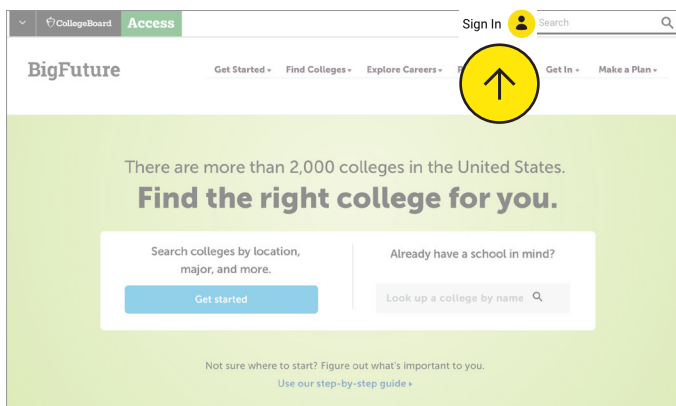


# How to Build a College List

The next step in your academic career is exploring colleges and finding what’s right for you. We can help.

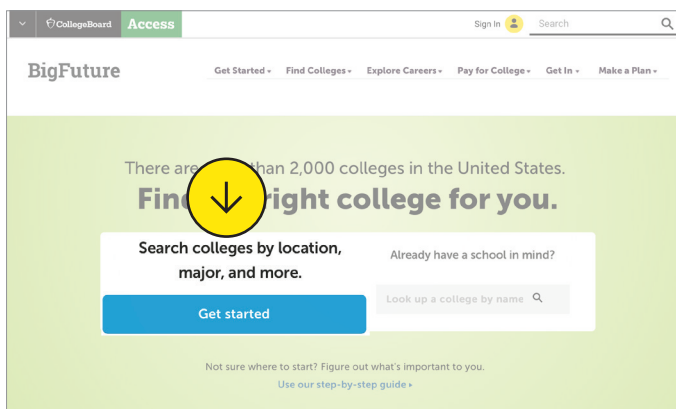
## 1 CREATE A FREE COLLEGE BOARD ACCOUNT

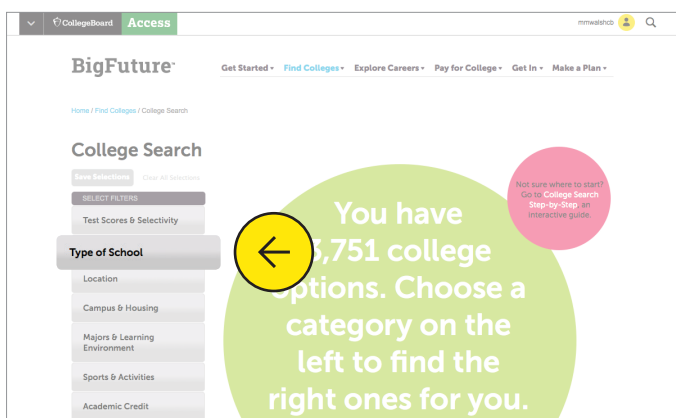
## 2 SEARCH COLLEGES BY LOCATIONS, MAJORS, AND MORE

## 3 CHOOSE A FILTER TO GET STARTED

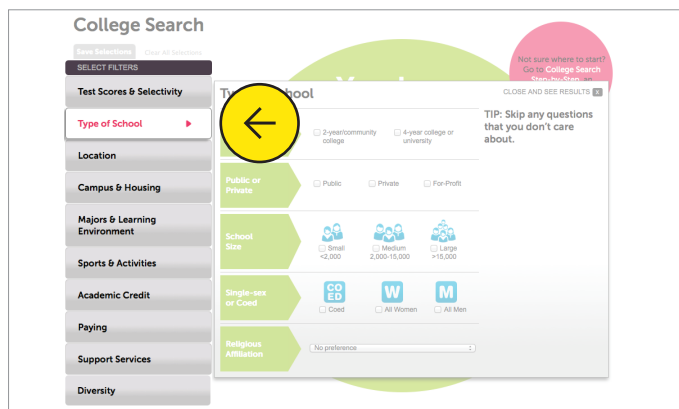
Start with one that’s important to you—from type of school, test scores, location, majors, cost/financial aid, sports, or any other popular category.



You have 3,751 college options. Choose a category on the left to find the right ones for you.

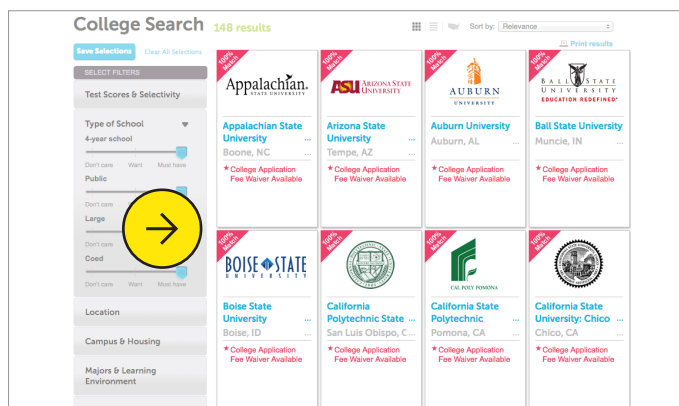
## 4 SELECT YOUR PREFERENCES AND GET GUIDANCE ON EVERY STEP

Review your options and answer the questions. You'll get tips and advice as well as videos from college planning experts and college students to help you understand your choices.



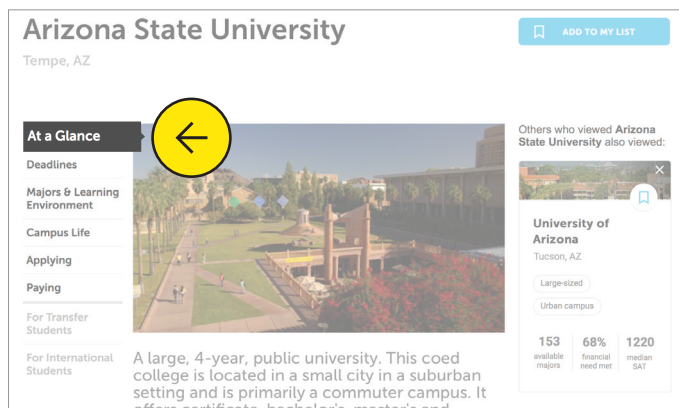
## 5 GET YOUR SEARCH RESULTS

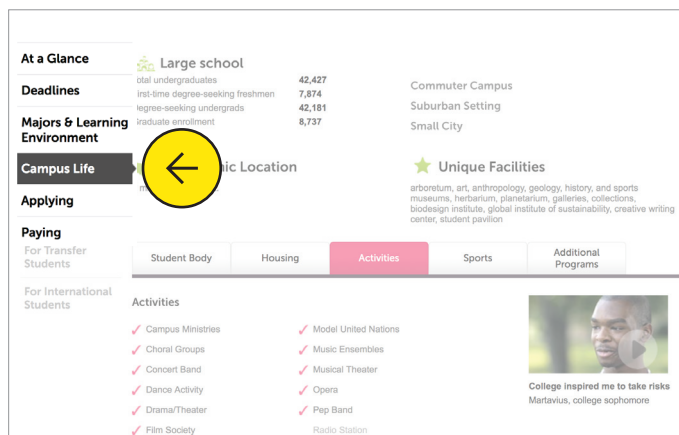
## 6 CHOOSE A COLLEGE TO EXPLORE
