


Using the state platform for STAAR scores.

- 1) Go to [www.texasassessment.gov](http://www.texasassessment.gov)
- 2) On the home page, look for “view your child’s Test Results”. See picture below.

- 5) Fill out the information required and click Go. It will give you the student access code for your student, which will then take you to your student’s entire testing history in Texas.
