Keller ISD Students and Parents,

As we move further into the year, we just wanted to send a reminder regarding fan behavior at sporting events. Please review the reminders below, and we appreciate your cooperation and adherence to the District's policies.

Student Behavior Expectations at Campus Events, Including the Keller ISD Athletics Complex
Student behavior toward staff, other students, adult spectators, and teams must be respectful at all
times. Disrespectful behavior – including disobeying event staff, creating a disruption, etc. – will
result in immediate removal from the event and be subject to additional disciplinary action in
accordance with the Keller ISD Student Code of Conduct, which may include a loss of privileges to
attend future school events on or off campus for the remainder of the semester.

Behaviors such as fighting will result in a loss of privileges to attend future school events, on or off campus, for the remainder of the school year.

Students are not allowed to congregate anywhere other than in the student seating sections. If students are grouped together in walkways, under the stands/bleachers, etc., they will be asked to return to their seats or exit the facilities. If a student leaves the event, there is no re-entry allowed.

Student, Parent, and Spectator Expectations at Campus Events, Including the Keller ISD Athletics Complex

To ensure that all spectators have a positive experience at campus events and athletics events, the following expectations will be enforced:

Spectators shall cheer for their team and will refrain from yelling at game officials, opposing
players, or other spectators. Spectators removed from an event due to behavior that is
deemed inappropriate by the officials, campus/district administration, event staff, or local
law enforcement could be banned from attending any events for the remainder of the
semester and/or school year.

Our vision: An exceptional district in which to learn, work, and live.

- Students will need to have their student ID with them and be prepared to show it if asked. Student's will be required to show their ID at basketball games held at Fossil Ridge.
- Students attending events that do not include their home campus team must be accompanied by a parent.
- Students must remain in their seats or "move with purpose" to or from concessions/restroom areas.
- Students must sit either in the designated student section or with their immediate family.
- Spectators must sit on the side designated for their team (home/away).
- For events in the gym, students must be in the bleachers and cannot stand on the floor.
- At no point should any spector (student or adult) go onto the court/playing field including at the end of the game.
- All spectators must be in the stands in a seat. To ensure there is a safe and clear access
 way for spectator movement in or out of the stands, spectators will not be allowed to sit or
 stand along railings/walkways.
- Spectators are not permitted to spray/throw items at the game, including baby powder, confetti, or water. Additionally, artificial noisemakers (such as air horns) are not permitted.
- Signage displayed shall encourage your own team and not be directed at or mention the opposing team.
- There is no re-entry once you leave the event.
- Parents and guardians are expected to pick up students promptly at the end of all Keller ISD events. Any student remaining beyond 30 minutes after the end of the event/game may be suspended from attending future events/games.
- Parents and guardians are asked to accompany their students to KISD events or be available by phone, if needed.
