- This scheduled was developed through collaboration with the KISD High School principals, high school teacher leadership teams, high school teaching staffs, research of comparable district, collaboration with stakeholder functions and departments.
- This is an innovative schedule designed to meet the needs of KISD students now and into the future.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SCHEDULE

Aligned with HB 5

- Increase credit offerings per year/4 year plan
- Increase choice and supports student engagement in co-curriculum offerings

Academic Support

Supports direction of CTE programming

- Fostering blocked classes for CTE lab-based courses
- Enabling 2 and 3 credit CTE courses into a student's schedule without creating a sacrifice on other programs.
- Supports a CTE student in scheduling a coherent sequence of courses over 4 years.
- > Aids CTE in transportation of students to Practicum and DC which often requires a transportation period

- For funding purposes, we increase weighted funding and advanced CTE coding.
